Signposting for patient direct access during Covid Pandemic

Gloucestershire Breastfeeding Support Network (GBSN) is a charity funded service which runs six breastfeeding groups across Gloucestershire. They run groups with a highly skilled breastfeeding support workers and are supported by trained peer supporters. Mothers can be supported with any breast-feeding issues including stopping. Groups across the week Monday to Thursday. Mums are free to attend any group no matter where they live. There are also online FB groups affiliated with some groups.
